

How to use Owncloud

Owncloud is a service similar to Dropbox where you can upload your files to our server and access them from everywhere using a webbrowser, desktop client or an app for your mobile phone. You can share files with others, play music, view photos, etc.

First of all you need an account to access Owncloud. If you want to use the service, please send me an email and I'll create an account for you:

After you received your login and password, you can access your folder by entering the following address to your browser:

The web interface is pretty much self-explaining. If you click your username in the top right corner, you can change your personal settings like language and password.

Please change your password after you logged in for the first time!

If you don't want to use the browser interface, you can install an Owncloud-client as well. Clients are available for Windows, Mac and Linux desktops as well as for iPhone and Android. Find all information and downloads here:
